### Procedure of application

Applicants who are working in **kindergarten, primary or secondary schools or in adult education** as a teacher or other professionals (e.g. educational psychologists, counsellors, therapists), and who are **residents of the European Union (except Romanians)<sup>1</sup> and EFTA countries**, may apply for a **Comenius 2.2c (In-service teacher training) or Grundtvig 3 (Adult education) grant** to their respective National Life-Long Learning Programme LLP Agencies ( NA).

1. first contact your National LLP Agency (NA) to download the necessary forms from the National Agencies's website. Addresses of the NA's can be found on: [http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/llp/national\\_en.html](http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/llp/national_en.html)
2. Ask a "preliminary acceptance letter" from the organizer in Europe = University of Antwerp, Project Learning Enhancement & inclusion, c/o prof. Jozef Lebeer, Campus 3Eiken, Universiteitsplein 1, 2610 Wilrijk, Belgium, fax +32 3 820 25 26, e-mail [jo.lebeer@ua.ac.be](mailto:jo.lebeer@ua.ac.be). Send a *brief motivation (name & address of correspondence, profession, age, workplace, motivation why you want to do this course, preliminary knowledge about Feuerstein's theories, involvement in inclusive education or not)*. An acceptance letter from the University of Antwerp is only "on principle". Under no circumstances this can invoke any claim for a free participation.

3. Then send a duly filled-out application form to your National Agency, together with the acceptance letter from University of Antwerp BEFORE JANUARY 16<sup>th</sup> 2010
4. Simultaneously as applying for a grant, the participant must register at the ICELP (International Centre for the Enhancement of Learning Potential, Jerusalem – [www.icelp.org](http://www.icelp.org) ) send your application as well to the Workshops' organizer [alexk@icelp.org.il](mailto:alexk@icelp.org.il) , mentioning that registration is dependent on the grant approval.
5. Accommodations reservations must be made by you, mentioning that you want a single room or a shared room (prices depend on this). We will send you the details of this information as soon as possible
